1. Introduction

The Rencontre Réconciliation website (hereinafter “the Site”) uses cookies to improve users' browsing experience, provide specific functionalities, and collect statistical data. This cookie policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and how you can manage them.

2. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, smartphone or other device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used to make websites work, improve their efficiency, and provide information to site owners.

3. Types of cookies used

The site uses different types of cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies: These cookies are essential for browsing the site and using its functions. They cannot be deactivated in our systems.
- Performance cookies: These cookies collect information on how users use the site, such as the most frequently visited pages or error messages. They enable us to improve the operation of the site.
- Functional cookies: These cookies enable the Site to remember the choices you make (such as your username, language or region) and to provide enhanced and personalized functionality.

4. Cookie management

On your first visit to the Site, a banner informs you of the use of cookies. You can accept or refuse the use of certain cookies, with the exception of those that are strictly necessary.

You can also configure your browser to block or delete cookies installed on your device. Please note that deactivating certain cookies may affect your browsing experience on the Site.
